



Graduates of continuing education programmes, 1996–2010, persons







Attracting Talented Students from Russia and CIS

- Special competitions ('*olympics*') for 9,311 high-school students applying for Bachelor's and 3,038 undergraduate students applying for Master's from 34 Russian regions and 7 CIS countries in 2010-2011
- Ten nationwide career-guidance winter schools for the undergraduate students aiming to apply for Master's programmes
- Free preparatory program for 300 students applying for the master's programme



Attracting talented students from Russia and CIS

- More than 50% of enrolled undergraduate students come from non-Moscow areas of Russia and CIS
- More than 50% of students enrolled for Master's and PhD programmes come from the other universities
- 30% of students enrolled for Master's take a programme which is different from their previous degree



Seizing the market for Master's programs

- Number of Master's programs increased from 18 to 75 in 2004-2011
- Enrollment of students increased from 317 to 1874 in 2004-2010
- Number of students in Master's programmes increased from 635 to 3251 in 2004-2010



Necessity to transform PhD Programs

- Only 17% of PhD students defended theses on time in 2010
- Stipends are much below subsistence level
- Most of PhD students have external full-time employment
- PhD students express low commitment to academic work



Start-up of a structured PhD program

- Selection of 12 best candidates from those enrolled for PhD program in economics, sociology and management
- Providing a monthly stipend of 25 000 rubles (approx. 600 EUR)
- Special individualized curricula
- Integration into ongoing research projects
- Co-supervising by international scholars
- Encouraging academic training at leading international universities for one semester



Internationalization of education

- Establishing double-degree teaching programmes
- Increasing the number of teaching courses and programmes in English
- Stimulating inflow of overseas students

Education in English

- Master's programmes in English
 - Master's in Financial Economics (with LSE)

- Increasing number of courses in English integrated into existing programs (Economics, Political Science, Sociology, etc.)
- Clusters of 88 courses for overseas students



Support for the best faculty members

- Special Fund for educational innovations
- Recruitment of 150-200 teaching assistants on a competitive basis and reduction of faculty members' teaching load
- Salary supplements to the 250-300 best teachers on a competitive basis
- Opportunities for continuous professional retraining of faculty members



Fund for Educational Innovations

- Teaching of new courses in English
- Original design of research seminars and workshops
- New approaches to regular seminars and introduction of interactive forms of teaching
- New ways of academic skills training
- Introduction of distance learning programmes
- Video recording of lecture courses of distinguished faculty members



Salary supplements to the best teachers

- Students voting for the best trainers
 - Best lecturers
 - Best supervisors of seminars and workshops
- Grants for research supervisors of students winning annual competition prizes



Development of institutional research

- Annual monitoring representative surveys
 of students and faculty members
- Annual monitoring surveys of candidates applying for the HSE educational programs
- First systematic study of the 1748 HSE graduates (Spring 2011)
