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# Expectations

### Dissatisfaction

- personal (subjective ill-being)
- political (confidence in institutions)
- tolerance and social trust

### Anti-Americanism

general vs. issue-oriented

### Antimodernism

- economic paternalism
- moral traditionalism and religiosity
- authoritarianism
- suspicion of technical progress



#### Countries

found in both WVS and Pew = 39 cases

### Pew Global Attitudes Project

survey for year 2007

### World Values Survey

- Wave 2005 data = default
- integrated Waves 1981-2000 data = substitution

### Software = Stata v.10.1 and Mplus v.4.2

- exploratory factor analysis
- Unification of items
  - all recoded into dummies

# Analysis

### Individual-level

- binomial variables
- 1 to 5 factors
- varimax rotation
- estimator = WLSMV

### Country-level

- weighted country means
- ranged from 0 to  $1 \rightarrow$  proportions
- logistic transformation
- variables treated as continuous
- estimator = ML

# Results

### Dissatisfaction

- internal consistency of subdimensions...
- ...but no "general dissatisfaction"
- cross-country variance of relationships

## Anti-Americanism

 consistency of "overall anti-Americanism" on both individual and national levels

# Antimodernism

- not all subdimensions are internally consistent...
- ...but traditionalism, religiosity, and opposition to gender equality form a consistent dimension
- supported on both levels

### Dimensions are clear

include both for dissatisfaction?

### Low DF problem


only simple models available
