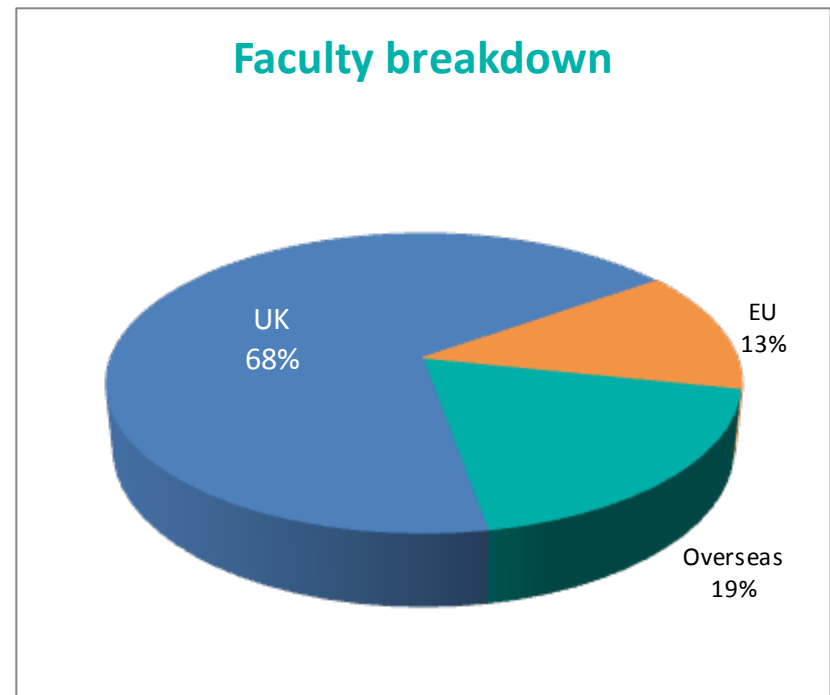
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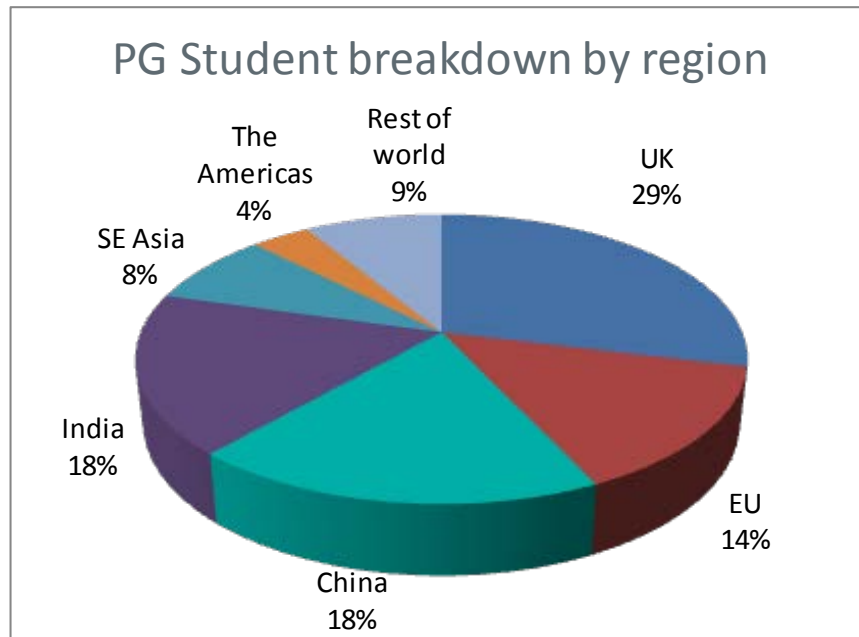

- Excellent transport links to Manchester, London and Edinburgh



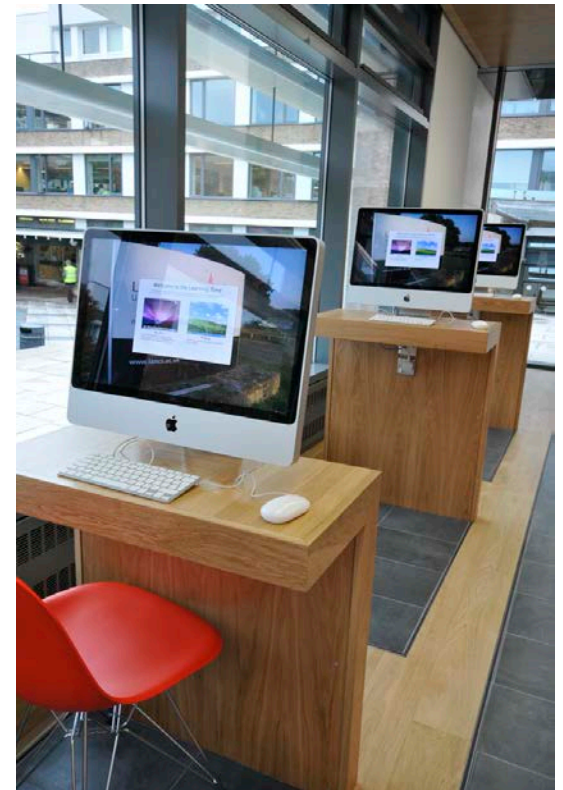

- Pearson Test of English (academic) 70 or
- Or Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) grade C or above
