EU-Russia International Co-operation

Context

- Russia has long tradition of research and development across a wide range of industries, including ICT
- There is a need to join forces to identify and address major challenges

Instruments

- EU-Russia Science & Technology Agreement (signed in 2000, entered into force in 2001)
- Renewed agreement (signed on 6 November 2003, entered into force on 20 February 2004)
- St. Petersburg Summit in May 2003 created in the long term four 'common spaces', one of them is Research & Development



Area of Research & Development

Objectives:

- structuring a knowledge-based society in the EU and Russia
- promoting a high rate of competitiveness and economic growth by modernization of the national economies and implementation of advanced technology
- strengthening and optimizing the links between research and innovation
- maintaining small and medium size entrepreneurship in the field of research and innovation

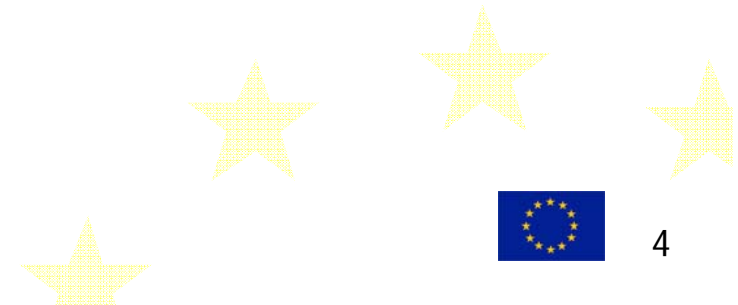
