Commitment to Capitalism

- V126. <u>Ownership on Business</u>
- 10 points scale from More Private to More Government
- V127. <u>Responsibility</u>
- 10 points scale from State responsibility to Individual responsibility
- V128. Competition
- 10 points scale from Competition is good to Competition is harmful.

Anti-Capitalism Index

- Recoded V126 to V126_1, 10 points scale from 0 to 1
- Reversed V127 and Recoded to V127_1, 10 points scale from 0 to 1
- Recoded V128 to V128_1, 10 points scale from 0 to 1

Anti_cap=V126_1+V127_1+V128_1

Results of T-Test for Ex-Communist and Other Countries

- 1 subsample People from Ex-Communist Countries in Europe, N=31049
 mean of anti_cap =1.47
- 2 subsample People from Other countries, N=53741

mean of anti_cap=1.26
t=42.4 , Sig. = 0

Results of T-test for East and West Germany


 1 subsample – People from West Germany (N=963)

mean anti_cap=1,1

 2 subsample – People from East Germany (N=940)

mean anti_cap=1,4 t=-13,8 Sig.=0

Spirit of Capitalism

- Freedom of Choice
- V66 freedom of choice about control their life. 10 points scale from Not at all to Great Deal.

Recode V66 to freed_index, 10 points scale from 0 to 1.

• Security.

Sec_index =confidence (army, police, courts) .

• Justice.


Correlation coefficients between level of education and level of income.

Anti-Capitalism and Spirit of Capitalism




Nationalism

Cohort Analysis of Nationalism



Hypothesis

 The success of economic and political reforms in the countries of East and Central Europe depended from level of nationalism in the country. In countries where reforms has been successful the level of anti-capitalism sentiments due to concept of spirit of capitalism. In the countries where reforms realized less successful level of anti-capitalist sentiments can be explain by the level of nationalism.
