

Student Exchange Agreement for 2013/14 between the Faculty of Education of The University of Hong Kong and the Graduate School of Education of the Higher School of Economics, Moscow

The Faculty of Education of The University of Hong Kong (HKU) and the Graduate School of Education of the Higher School of Economics, Moscow (HSE) agree to implement this Student Exchange Agreement:

HKU will provide support to research postgraduate students from HSE. This will include:


- Hosting of up to two HSE students' visits to HKU for up to 7 days/6 nights in May or December 2014 to participate in the Faculty of Education Postgraduate Research Conference, providing accommodation at university guest house (or equivalent), financial subsidy for meals and airport pickup services and support for access to libraries, campus internet connection, and related facilities as possible;
- Assistance in obtaining Visa for exchange students if necessary; and
- Provision of access to seminars and classes taking place on campus and social activities organized by students at the time of the visit.

HSE will provide support to research postgraduate students from HKU. This will include:

- Hosting of up to two HKU students' visits to HSE for up to 7 days/6 nights in 2014 to participate in international conferences hosted by HSE, providing accommodation at university guest house (or equivalent), financial subsidy for meals and airport pickup services and support for access to libraries, campus internet connection, and related facilities as possible;
- Assistance in obtaining Visa for exchange students if necessary; and
- Provision of access to seminars and classes taking place on campus and social activities organized by students at the time of the visit.

HKU and HSE will each provide return economy airfare for their own students for the visits. Students will be under the travel insurance coverage arranged by their own institution and/or travel insurance taken out at students' own expense. In each institution, the exchange students participating in the programme shall be subject to the host institution's policies and regulations concerning research personnel and intellectual property.

The collaboration of both institutions will be characterized by mutual respect and continuing communication. This Agreement shall take effect from the date of the last signature till the end of 2014 and may be modified or revised by mutual written consent of the two institutions. In the event of cancellation of this Agreement, both parties shall provide all normal support services as outlined herein for the current group of participating students until the end of their exchange.
