<b>3</b>	<b>Relevance of applicant's research papers to the directions of Master's programme</b> Research papers presented by an applicant (articles, conference theses, etc) are related to the fields of a) cognitive psychology, b) cognitive neurophysiology or psychophysiology, c) cognitive linguistics, d) artificial intelligence or machine learning, e) philosophy of mind. Relevance of presented documents to the direction of Master's programme is assessed by a committee.	<b>5</b>
<b>4</b>	<b>Experimental work experience reflected in the research papers (articles, conference theses, etc)</b> (understood as the controlled influence coupled with independent variables manipulation and the measurement of dependent variables and targeted at causal hypotheses examination)	<b>5</b>

<b>6.1</b>	Individual stipend or grant for education and/or training in one of the universities which are in top-500 of any international rankings of higher education (Shanghai Ranking, Times Higher Education, QS)	<b>15</b>
