Young Scientist Symposium on Applied Data Analysis (PiterADA 2016)

February 4-5, 2016

We warmly invite you and your students to the Young Scientist Symposium on Applied Data Analysis (PiterADA 2016) to be held in St. Petersburg (Russia) within St. Petersburg International Student Research Forum from February 4-5, 2016 in conjunction with Master's Program 'Big Data Analysis for Business, Economy and Society'.

The Young Scientist Symposium on Applied Data Analysis is a conference for graduate and undergraduate students who apply modern mathematical, computer science and statistical methods (Machine Learning, Network Science, Text Mining) to various areas and problems, i.e. in Economics, Business, studying Web and Digital Footprints of people behaviour, Computational Social Science and Learning Analytics. Our symposium is a meeting place to exchange ideas with people of different backgrounds, discuss your ideas, find new contacts and uncover hidden data sources.

We welcome submissions of approx. 500 word abstracts describing research results, novel approaches or tools. Both work in progress and previously published works can be presented. Each accepted submission will be presented in the poster session and during 2-3 minute short presentation slot.

The most interesting submissions will be selected for 15-minute plenary presentations.

Applications should be submitted at <http://hse.ru/piterdata> before December 29, 2015. The list of accepted works will be announced before January 15, 2016.

Application: Abstract (approx. 500 words, in English, in PDF or MS Word) should be uploaded through the registration form on <http://hse.ru/piterdata>. It shall include: Project title, author(s) name(s), email(s), affiliation(s), short description of works, (expected) results.

There is no participation fee. Please note that health insurance, travel, accommodation and living expenses are covered by participants.

Publication: Conference abstracts will be published in an electronic form.
