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Michael Keenan (BSc. MA PhD) is a Senior Policy Analyst in the OECD's Directorate for Science, Technology and Industry. He has worked in the innovation policy field for around two decades, most of which was spent at the Manchester Institute of Innovation Research, where he remains an Honorary Research Fellow. He is on the editorial boards of several international journals, including *Technological Forecasting and Social Change*, *Foresight*, and *Asian Research Policy*.
