Until 2011, she was the Director of Policy, Strategy, FP7 and International with core responsibility for the National Research and Innovation Strategy and Foresight and links with the European Union. She currently retains a part-time consultancy role with the Council.

Dr Harper is active at European and international level as advisor, reviewer, speaker and expert group member.
