Online student profile completion deadlines	<p>Fall Semester Dates (second half of year) – <b>15th of May</b>          Spring Semester Dates (first half of year) – <b>15th of October</b></p>
Visa (if necessary)	<p>The HSE provides visa support for international students. A formal invitation from the HSE is required to get a student visa. Initially, a 90-day single-entry visa will be given to a student, which will then be extended for the whole period of exchange.</p>
