**On Establishing Additional Discounts on Tuition Fees for Foreign Citizens and Stateless Persons Upon Application to HSE's Higher Educational Programmes as Part of Separate Competition for Places Under Educational Agreements Funded by Individuals and/or Legal Entities.**

For the purposes of increasing the total number of foreign citizens and stateless persons (hereinafter, "foreign citizens") studying at National Research University Higher School of Economics (hereinafter, the "University", or "HSE") under degree programmes, who have applied for study as part of a separate competition for places education agreements funded by individuals and/or legal entities, and in accordance with Point 14 of the Regulations on the Provision of Discounts on Tuition Fees to Foreign Citizens and Stateless Persons, who are studying at HSE in 2017 under degree programmes as part of a separate competition for places under education agreements funded by individuals and/or legal entities, approved by HSE Academic Council Minutes No. 04, dated April 7, 2017,

I HEREBY INSTRUCT THE FOLLOWING:

1. establishment of the following types and grounds for the provision of additional discounts on tuition fees to foreign citizens applying for study at HSE in 2017 under degree programmes as part of a separate competition for places under educational agreements financed by individual and/or legal entities:

1.1. discounts upon application for study at HSE under Bachelor's and Specialist's programmes based on the results of entry examinations (each entry exam must be successfully passed):

1.1.1. a 70% discount on the tuition fee for a given educational programme set for the current academic year – for scores of 160 points or higher;

1.1.2. a 50% discount on the tuition fee for a given educational programme set for the current academic year – for scores between 140 and 159 points;

1.1.3. a 25% discount on the tuition fee for a given educational programme set for the current academic year – for scores between 120 and 139 points;

1.2. discounts upon application for study at HSE under a Master's programme based on the results of entry examinations;

1.2.1. a 50% discount on the tuition fee for a given educational programme set for the current academic year – for portfolio contest scores of 75 points or higher;

1.2.2. a 25% discount on the tuition fee for a given educational programme set for the current academic year – for portfolio contest scores between 60 and 74 points.

2. for Vice Rector I.V. Prostakov to post information on the establishment of additional tuition discounts for foreign citizens or stateless persons upon application to HSE in 2017 to the University's corporate website (portal).
