About the Program

Master's Degree Program "International Relations: European and Asian Studies" is aimed at training foreign-policy and foreign economic specialists. For this purpose, the Program focuses on teaching students to master methods of complex analysis of global political and economic problems and trends in international relations development, as well as on studying the political and economic agenda of the world's key regions. Special emphasis is placed on the increasing interrelation between the economy and politics in modern international affairs.

The Program embraces four specializations:

- Russia in the World
- European Studies
- Asian Studies
- The Middle Fast

The Program's particular goal is to raise specialists capable of advancing the interests of Russia's public and private sectors on critical regional IR tracks:

- Relations with the EU (European Studies)
