


Laboratory was established in the National Research University Higher School of Economics, in 2010 when professors Ronald Inglehart and Eduard Ponarin were awarded a mega-grant




ПОДГОТОВКА ПОРТФОЛИО: 5 СОВЕТОВ



Рекомендации – слово, которое звучит солидно и пугает значимостью. На самом деле это максимально просто и логично: рекомендации от людей, с которыми вы взаимодействовали ранее, помогают сделать образ живым и объемным

Хорошая рекомендация включает справку о том, кому она дается, какие остались впечатления о совместной работе и как вы сможете реализоваться на выбранной программе с точки зрения рекомендателя



При личной встрече используйте мотивационное письмо как опору, добавив фактурных деталей (хобби, поездки, увлечения). Вам будут задавать вопросы относительно предполагаемой темы исследования, поэтому важно подготовить одну или несколько тем, ознакомиться с литературой. Воспринимайте собеседование как карьерную консультацию, где лучшие профессора помогают выбрать образовательный трек
