Elena Dragalina-Chernaya:

How did your cooperation with Brazilian colleagues start?

We collaborate with the Center for Logic, Epistemology and History of Science (CLE) of the Brazilian State University of Campinas (UNICAMP). Our academic friendship began with participation in joint conferences, writing monographs, and visit exchanges.

Did the "International Academic Cooperation" competition boost your cooperation?

Yes, it was an excellent chance for us not only to institutionalize an already established academic partnership, but also to outline research perspectives. We are launching a joint project on pluralism in modern logic and formal philosophy.

Why have you chosen this topic?

Broadly speaking, the research on logical pluralism can give us a better understanding of the premises and limits of our rationality and can lead to a constructive dialog between different sciences and cultures. You know, mathematical and methodological difficulties are caused by the diversity of logical systems. The chosen research topic involves a joint effort of logicians-philosophers and logicians-mathematicians. We expect to get not only inspiring mathematical results to satisfy our scientific curiosity, but also to apply them in computer science.

We will also organize Russian-Brazilian conferences and schools that will unite and develop the already established traditions of the CLE and the International Laboratory of Logic, Linguistics, and Formal Philosophy.
