Aurora consortium offers an academic mobility program consisting of 20 partner institutions from Europe and Russia. Project is coordinated by the University of Turku in Finland and funded by the European Union within Erasmus Mundus Program.

Erasmus Mundus Program Consists of three actions: 1. Joint Master and Doctorate Programs, 2. Partnerships, 3. Promotion projects.

Aurora project aims to enhance international cooperation in the field of higher education by awarding scholarships for students and university staff in partner universities. Academic opportunities for studies, research and professional development are available to citizens of EU countries and Russian Federation to Partner Universities. Aurora develops management capacity of Partner Universities e.g. sharing good practices on mobility and mobility administration; creating transparent administration procedures to enhance mutual responsibility and accountability in the decision-making; and improving transparency and recognition of studies and qualifications.
