

Annex No. 2, p.18 to Directive No. 302n

Once a year, all employees of educational and academic organizations of all types must take part in mandatory medical examinations (check-ups).

The examinations include the following:

Screenings by the following specialists:

1. General Practitioner;
2. Ophthalmologist;
3. Dermatovenerologist;
4. Otorhynolaryngologist
5. Psychiatrist /Narcologist;
6. Dentist and Infectious Disease Specialist (by referral only);
7. Gynecologist - bacterial and pap-test (only for women);
8. Mammology or breast ultrasonography - once every two years (only for woman above the age of 40).

Tests:

1. Blood test::
 - clinical (Hb, colour index, RBCs, PLTs, WBCs, white blood cell formula, ESR, HIV, syphilis);
 - bio-chemical screening for glucose, and cholesterol, clinical blood test, clinical urine test (USG, protein, sugar, urinary sediment);
2. electrocardiography;
3. digital fluorography or X-Ray analysis with two lung projections (frontal and right lateral).
