Scholarships & Funding

- **10% fee discount**
- **Partnerships Scholarships** - £10,000 (limited to 8 students)
- **Departmental Scholarships** – generally £1000 - £4000, based on academic excellence

Scholarships & Funding

Example 1: MSc E-Business and Innovation and MSc Human Resource Management

Tuition fees:	£20,000
10% partnership discount	£2,000
Partnership scholarship	£10,000
	£8,000 and also the possibility of departmental scholarships

Example 2: MSc Business Analytics, MSc Project Management MSc Finance, MSc Quantitative Finance, MSc Money, Banking and Finance

Tuition fees:	£23,000
10% partnership discount	£2,300
Partnership scholarship	£10,000
	£10,700 and also the possibility of departmental scholarships

Living costs

Campus accommodation (12 months) 4,800 GB - 5,800 GBP (depending on type)

Food/ subsistence estimate 2,800 GBP

Books, stationery, clothes, local travel, entertainment etc. estimated at 2,000 GBP

Entry Requirements & Funding

Entry Requirements:

Upper second class honours degree or equivalent in specified disciplines = GPA 4.0

English Language proficiency:

- IELTS 7.0 (with at least 6.0 in each element)
- iBTTOEFL 100
- Pearson Test of English (academic) 70 with at least 55 in each element
- Cambridge Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) grade C or above

English language exemption for EU nationals – certified by HSE

How to Apply?

1. You have to be nominated by HSE first
2. HSE will make the first selection and will notify Lancaster of selected candidates
3. Selected candidates will be asked to apply online by 15th March 2020 to be considered for the partnership scholarship and upload the following documents:
 - Contact details of 2 referees (one must be academic)
 - Bachelors degree transcript
 - First semester HSE Masters transcript
 - Language test certificate
 - Personal motivation statement – max 2 pages
